

What is Cascaded Course Evaluation Model?

The cascaded model is not only focused on the core set of teaching & learning priorities across an institution but also takes into consideration the **diversity** of the teaching & learning **priorities** <u>across schools</u>, <u>departments</u>, and courses.

In the other words, the cascaded model not only enables institution to have data for reporting and also gives stakeholders at all levels the ability to select additional questions for more customized feedback.


How course evaluation results are used

- Summative purposes
 - A means to make personnel decisions, such as hiring, tenure, promotion, and annual review
 - Accreditation purpose to meet the growing expectation from government and the public for transparency and accountability from post-secondary, publicly-funded universities
- Formative purposes
 - Helping faculties to improve on specific teaching aspects (approachability, communication skills, enthusiasm, organization skills, etc.)
- Analytics purposes
 - Learning analytics to improve learning environments and outcomes
 - Institutional analytics to improve administrative or business processes



How can we avoid <u>survey fatigue</u> while aiming to ensure that all stakeholders have the ability to collect meaningful data at the same time?




Not every school within my institution is ready to manage course evaluations centrally














When one question is selected by more than one department, can we compare each department's score against the institutional norm for this question?
