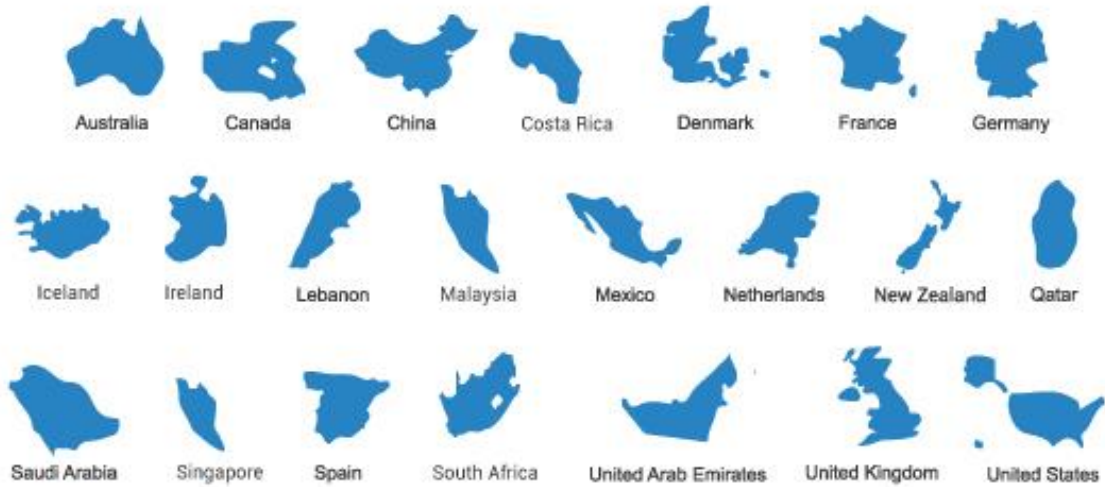

Vice Provost – Academic Accountability, Institutional Research, Effectiveness, and Analytics

Keynote Address: *Analytics in Higher Education: The pathway to our future*

Mr. Robert S. Goldstein has nearly 15 years of experience in institutional research, institutional effectiveness and analytics at the University of Louisville. Since 2013, he has served as the Vice Provost for Institutional Research, Assessment and Analytics where he supports several key university-wide functions, including institutional research, data analytics and visualization, strategic planning, and institutional effectiveness. Together with Assistant University Provost/SACSCOC liaison, he is also responsible for all matters concerning institutional accreditation.

Bob joined the University of Louisville in 2004 as the Director of Institutional Research and Planning. He was appointed assistant provost in 2007 and served as associate provost from 2008 until his appointment as vice provost in 2013. Prior to UofL, he served as the director of epidemiology and immunization at the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, Bureau of Communicable Disease Control.

Bob has been an active presenter at numerous state and national conferences. He is a member of the Association for Institutional Research (AIR) and the Kentucky Association for Institutional Research (KAIR). He has held several executive leadership roles within KAIR from 2009-2012. He serves as the university liaison to the Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education (CPE) on academic-specific data matters and issues related to academic program approval and review. Additionally, Bob serves as the institutional representative on the Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education's CPE Performance Funding Model Workgroup and the 2016-2020 Statewide Strategic Metric Advisory Group.

He has been an active participant in the Bluenotes Think Tank, participated extensively in the coordination of Blue Americas, and has provided consultation to eXplorance leadership to ensure alignment of the business development plan with newly emerging and/or evolving assessment and analytical requirements within Higher Education.

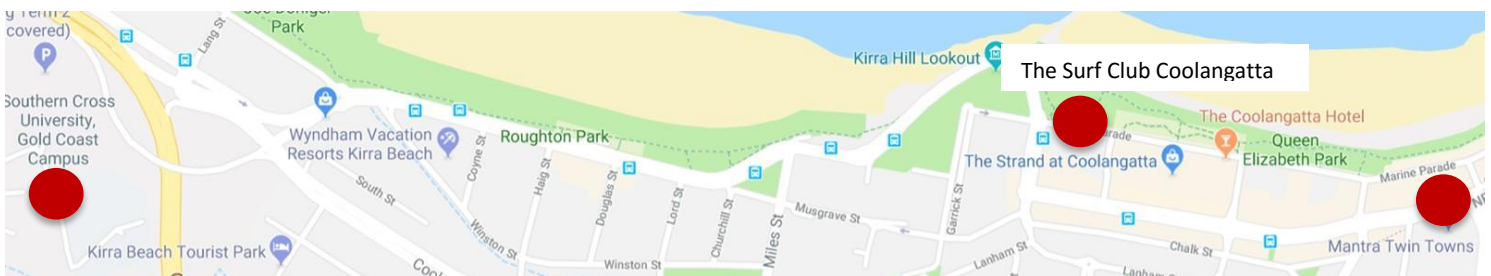
Gold Coast Campus Map
