1. Control of data integrity process is centralized

- Select what information can be updated
- Delegate clean-up tasks to the people that know the data
- Create rules to determine what can be viewed and modified
- Track progress to see what data has been validated









2. Increase efficiency and save time with automation

- Streamline processes with automated workflows
- Send automatic invitations and reminders
- Reduce workload for individuals preparing the data
- Eliminate manual intervention in Blue projects
- Run multiple data clean-up projects simultaneously









3. Manipulate data any way you want with flexible definitions

- Add, edit, or delete:
- Course data
- Course type data (merge and split courses)
- Course enrolment data
- Student information
- Teacher to course relationships
- Faculty & staff information
- Dates
- Data outside of the SIS









4. Improve data quality through an intelligent interface at the data entry point


- Use in-line validation capabilities to ensure data is accurate and complete
- Reduce manual errors
- Produce complete, reliable records


