



Comparing the Use of Results from National and Internal Student Experience Surveys – How Should Institutions Respond?

Description: In Australia, the Federal Government sponsors a series of national surveys on the student experience for current students and the employment outcomes of graduates. These surveys are conducted under uniform conditions at all universities and the aggregated results are made publicly available on the QILT website (https://www.qilt.edu.au/). The Federal Government is proposing to use these results as part of future funding arrangements with Universities. In addition, all universities in Australia undertake internal student experience surveys and these results are usually for internal use, including course enhancements and academic promotion. This presentation will examine aggregated results from a large research intensive university in Australia and compare how the results from both the national and internal student experience surveys are being used to drive changes within the institution.
