







Durham University's First Institution-wide Implementation of eXplorance Blue

Description: This presentation provides an overview of Durham's first institution-wide roll out of module evaluations using Blue 1,041 questions were mapped to 1,009 module evaluations, and were delivered to 11,987 undergraduates from 28 departments across the University (a total of 63,072 surveys to complete). The presenters discuss the way data was collected; the use of the Data Integrity Gateway (DIG) to allow departmental administrators to check and approve the information; and the development of a bespoke question bank tool (the QuBE) to automatically generate the feed files for use with DIG and Blue. They will reflect on this first high-stake implementation: the advantages, issues that arose and how they were dealt with. They will also share ways they encouraged high response rates. The session concludes with an audience discussion.
