









Blue <u>Task Listing Embedded</u> Directly into the LMS experience (via LTI Tool)









Diagnosis - I have a theory as to why I got this


Breakdown Filtering Result Comparison








Diagnosis - Drilldown

Please comment on the overall quality of the instruction in this course

- Jane uses great examples and is an enthusiastic professor.
- Jane took a practical approach to research methods which helped us learn how to critically examine scholarly research, in addition to helping us construct our own research proposals.
 The proposal presentations were beneficial for receiving critical feedback about our ideas, and this assignment was ultimately helpful for writing the final paper. There should be a participation grade for this course, because at times it appeared students did not do the readings and the same handful were the ones participating every class. A participation grade would also prevent students from talking during class and presentations, which was often a distraction.
- · knowledgeable of the course material and was clear in explanations
- Very broad, generalized lectures that did not provide meaningful, applicable information. When completing assignments, I used common sense and previous knowledge more than
 information from lectures. Her expectations and grading were unclear.

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- The course would have been much more useful if we learned specifically which statistical models were applicable to what kind of research- too much time was spent going over minor aspects of conducting research and very little time was spent on this aspect.
- Jane is extremely knowledgeable in the subject, great professor








Protecting student confidentiality

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


Course Evaluation Administrator
