

# LJMU Module Evaluation Journey: onwards and upwards

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# Liverpool John Moores University



- 22,400 students (around 18,300 undergraduate and 4,100 postgraduate students)
- 35th largest university in the UK by total student population.



# Blue at LJMU



- Piloted in 2014-15 in one Faculty followed by a thorough evaluation
- Ability to add module specific self-written questions (QP) and reporting on programme level were attractive functionalities
- Have been using Blue for four years for module evaluation only
- Central team (Academic Registry and Teaching and Learning Academy) - 4 people



# Recent developments



- Moved to Canvas in 2017
- Changed structure of modules – year long to semesterised
- Attempted mid-module evaluation for all modules
- Module evaluation responsive to institutional changes

# Student engagement

## Raising awareness, closing feedback loop:

- Engaging students via course reps/Students Union (facilitated workshop discussions)
  - Understanding disengagement/contributory factors
  - Showing/discussing evaluation reports that staff receive
- Timing brought forward to close feedback loop
- Published student reports – scores only





# Student engagement

## **Enhancing quality/usability of student evaluations:**

Additional guidance on:

- how to leave constructive comments

- avoiding unconscious bias

- anonymity aspects (via comments)

- frequently asked questions

Need to find easy, accessible way for student to access guidance

## **Response rates:**



In class completion works well, but not all module leaders on board; some student reps not confident in facilitating this; synch issues disabled links

# Staff Engagement Guidance

- Option to add more than two extra questions.
- Extended the amount of time given to staff to add questions.
- Developed guidance for writing quality self-written questions.

## Question Length

Questions that are too long can become confusing and are more prone to being double-barrelled.

	Rather than all group members automatically receiving the same mark for the group presentation, the use of WebPA was a fair way to allow marks to be adjusted to take into consideration an individual's contribution to the assessment.
	WebPA is a fair way to mark individual's contribution to the assessment.





## Bias and Leading Questions

When writing questions please try to avoid wording in a way that could lead a student to answer in a certain way. For example:

	It would be better to have a one hour workshop provided by an instructor and more time for independent online learning.
	Do you have any recommendations for how the structure of the module can be improved to best support your learning?

## Double-barrelled


Questions that cover multiple topics are hard for students to answer and analyse. The examples below highlight how any scale answer would not provide enough information about which aspects of the question the students agreed or disagreed with.

	The online resource provided an easier and more effective method of recording my progress, along with a higher frequency of updating my supervisor and faster way of obtaining feedback?
	The online resource was an effective method of recording progress?
	The module has covered more areas than I expected and I feel I now have a broader perspective and enhanced capability in various aspects of XXX.
	I feel the module has enhanced my capability in aspects of XXX.

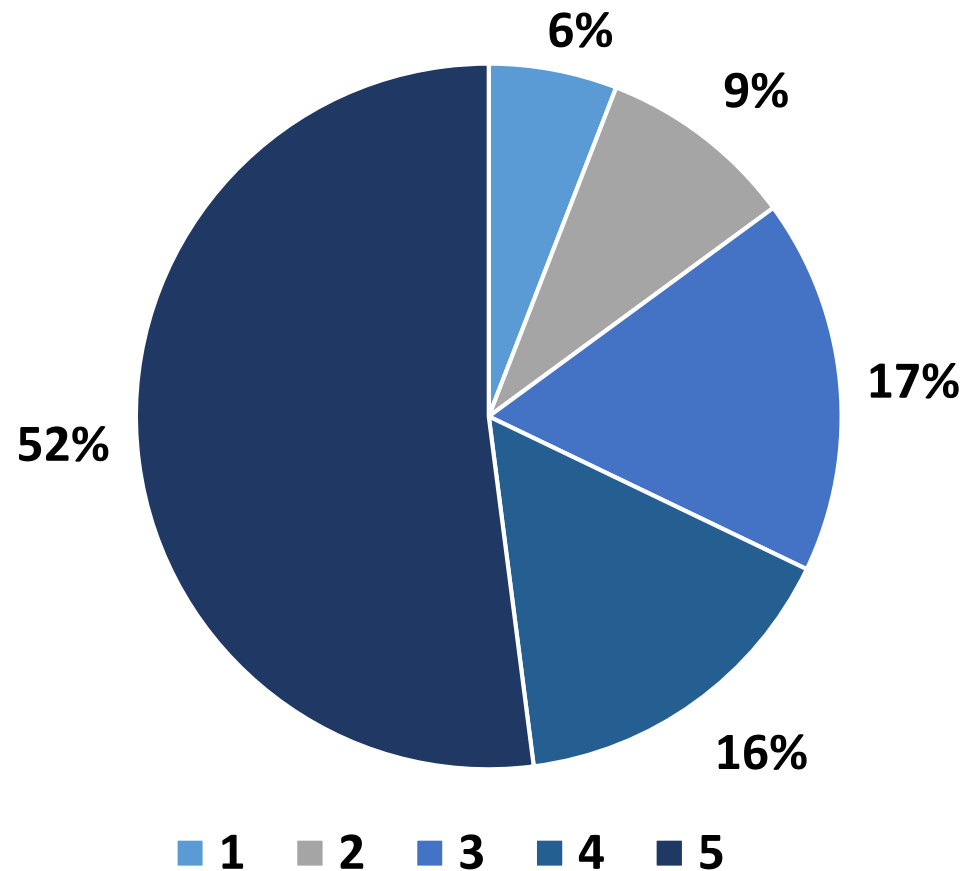

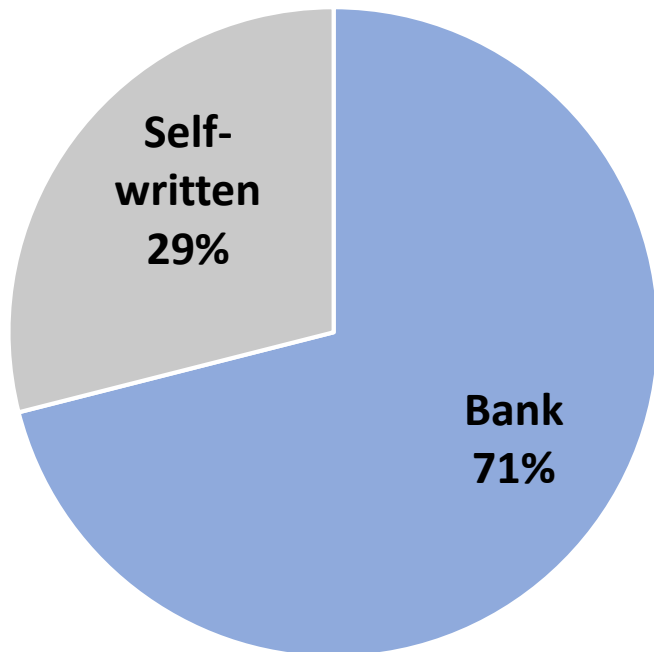
# QP usage by module



- 21% of modules in semester 1 had personalised questions.
- 52% of modules that selected personalised questions used all five available questions.

Number of QP selected	Count of Modules

# Bank questions vs. self written questions



- 221 modules selected questions from the bank or self written
- 157 from bank (71%)
- 64 (29%) modules used option to write their own question
- Total of 1104 QP questions including from bank and self written and across all modules
  - 104 self written – 9%

- There were a lot less self written questions compared with the previous year but more questions selected from the bank
- The self-written questions are very specific - asking for feedback on a particular intervention / assessment method / resource / learning etc
- The quality of the self-written questions were improved compared with last year.

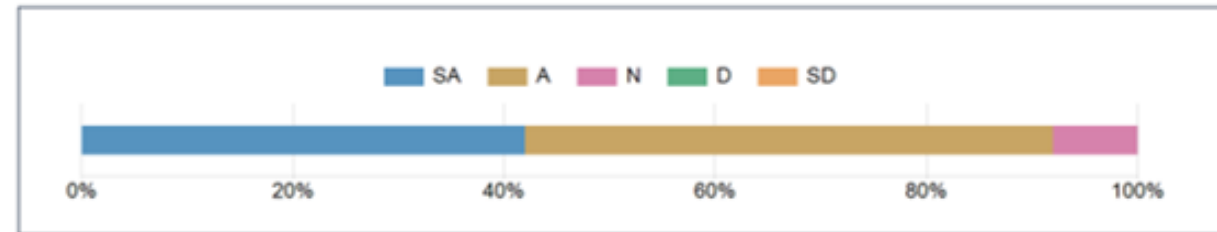

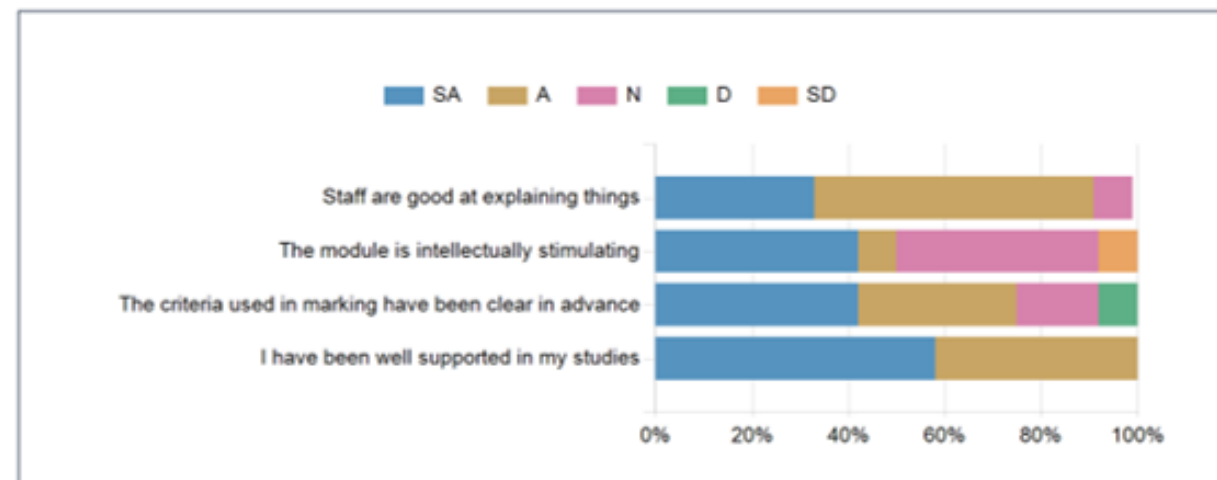
