





- Testing Services is responsible for the administration of the English Entrance Exam (EEE).
- The EEE measures applicants' level of proficiency in English. It is one of the tests that LAU accepts when assessing candidates for admission.
- The EEE is made up of three sections: A) Reading Test, B) Textual Analysis Test and C) Writing Test. The first two sections consist of multiple choice questions. The Writing Test includes It includes one suggestion for an essay.


Specific corrector question based on Group








