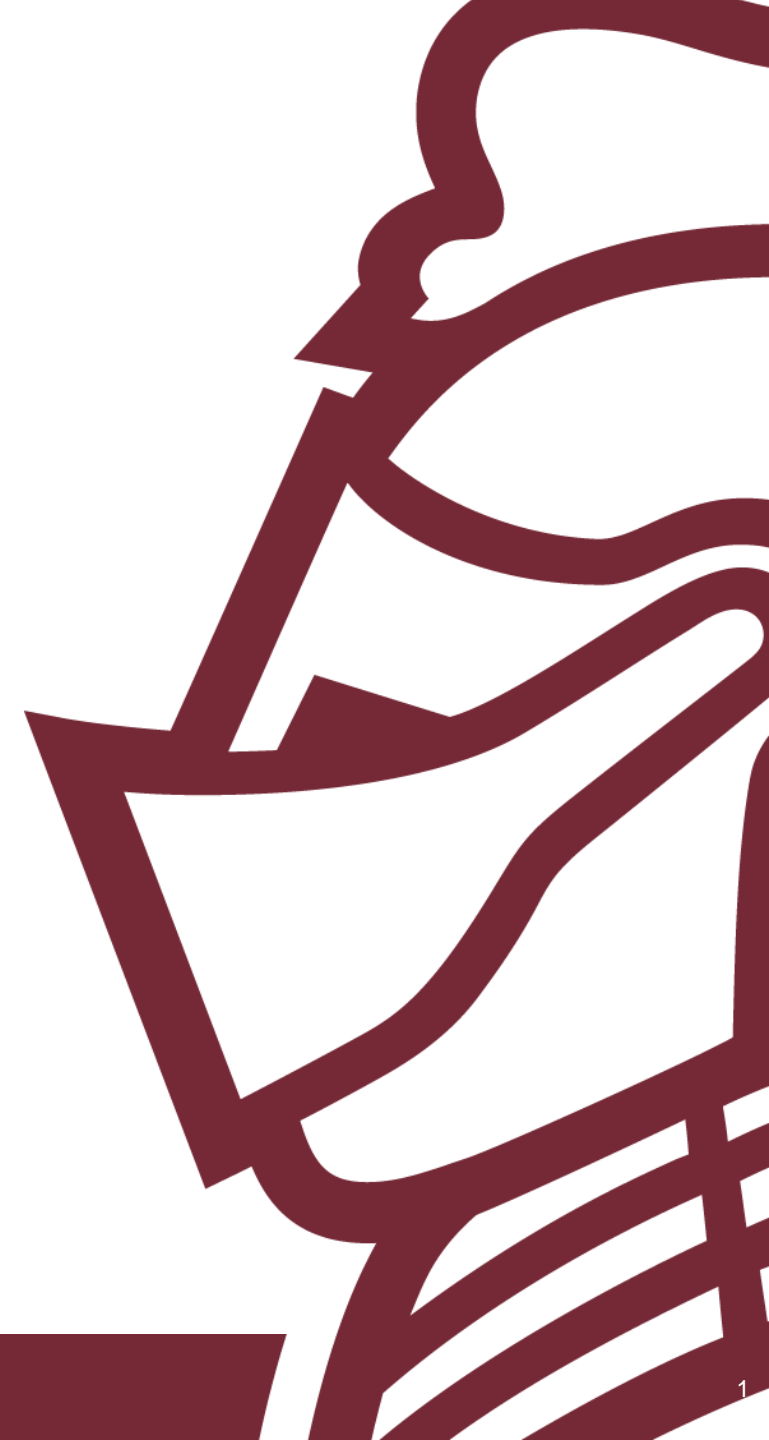

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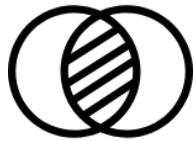
BELLARMINE UNIVERSITY

Defining the Problem





Defining the Problem

- Lack of a cohesive data collection strategy for survey data
- Multiple offices paying for professional survey accounts
- Multiple offices running redundant surveys in silos
- Lack of oversight re: use of data for assessment/effectiveness



Challenges

- Use of competing survey tools
- Small school, limited resources
- Survey form non-compliance
- Decentralization
- Ensuring community buy-in



Resources

- Building on our existing partnership with Explorance
- Eliminating redundancy / effective stewardship of resources
- Reinforcing survey request form process
- Promoting a cohesive approach to survey data
- Leveraging community skills with web-based survey tools

Developing the Policy





Goals of the Survey Policy

- Prevent survey fatigue
- Prevent overlapping or redundant surveys to the same population
- Promote effective survey design and methodology while offering training opportunities
- Safeguard data and protect respondent privacy
- Support data-informed decision making



Survey Administration Policy

The **Office of Institutional Research and Effectiveness** shall coordinate all surveys of Bellarmine community members. IR&E shall have primary responsibility for administering surveys or evaluations where the purpose is academic or operational assessment, accreditation, compliance, program evaluation, or other research connected to the University's institutional effectiveness efforts. Survey sponsors shall be responsible for demonstrating the extent to which collected feedback leads to meaningful and quality continuous improvement practices.

Survey Policy S.O.P.

Exempt from IR&E administration

Eligible for expedited IR&E administration

Requires full IR&E administration



Survey Policy S.O.P.

Exempt from IR&E administration

Type 1 – Notifying IR&E is **not required:**

- Data collection for administrative purposes
 - Nominations, elections, sign-up forms, event registration, meeting scheduling
- IRB-approved protocol requires confidentiality and PI doesn't need datasources
- One-time feedback on a class, program, or workshop
- Class projects surveying students only within the class



Survey Policy S.O.P.

Exempt from IR&E administration

Type 2 – Notifying IR&E is recommended but not required:

- Class projects involving deidentified (no PII) data for statistical exercises
- IRB-approved protocol requires confidentiality but the PI needs datasources
- Faculty and Staff Council administrative surveys



Survey Policy S.O.P.

Eligible for **expedited** IR&E administration

Notifying IR&E is **always required**.

At least one initial consultation with IR&E must take place to establish sample, date range, verbiage, etc. Later iterations may not require IR&E involvement.

Examples:

- Alumni surveys
- Health Services surveys
- Strategic Planning



Survey Policy S.O.P.

Requires full IR&E administration

Notifying IR&E is **always required**.

End-to-end involvement by IR&E for each iteration

Accountability for institutional effectiveness protocols/best practices

Examples:

- SETs, including field placement & clinical evaluations
- Student internship 360-degree evals
- Campus climate, satisfaction, or utilization surveys

Resources

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Why BlueX?

- IR&E doesn't have to administer every survey
- Everybody on campus can have their own creator account
- Familiar interface using web-based, Microsoft Word-esque editor
- Better administrator control and project management on back end
